

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY COURSE PLACEMENT EFFECTIVE FROM ACADEMIC SESSION 2026/2027

This guideline outlines the English language proficiency course placement requirements for students based on their cohort and English entry qualifications, effective from Academic Session 2026/2027. Students are required to follow the placement pathway applicable to their category to fulfil the English language proficiency course requirements for graduation.

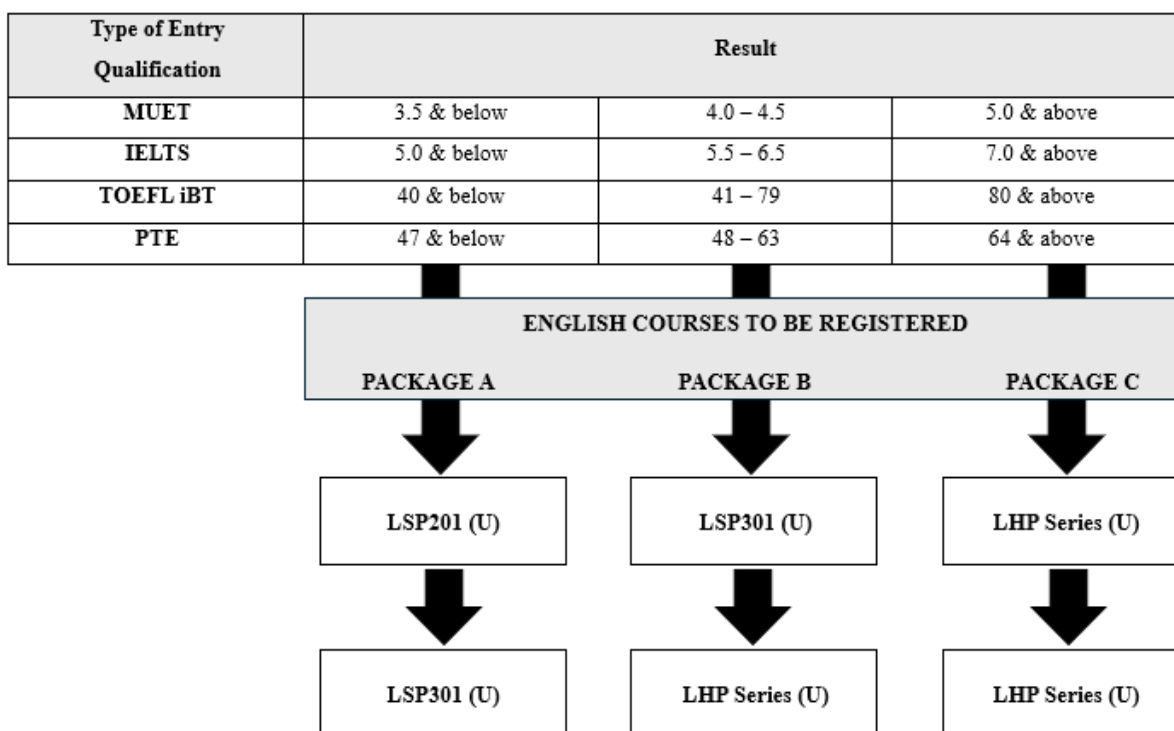
1. Students from the cohort of Academic Session 2025/2026 and prior to that who have enrolled in any English language proficiency courses.

- a. These students are required to register for the next level of English language proficiency course(s) until they successfully accumulate **4 University (U) type credits** for graduation requirements.
- b. The required course progression is as follows:
 - Students who started with and passed LSP101 (Z) are required to complete LSP201 (U) followed by LSP301 (U).
 - Students who started with and passed LSP201 (U) are required to complete LSP301 (U).
 - Students who started with and passed LSP301 (U) are required to complete one of the LHP series (U) courses.
 - Students who started with and passed one of the LHP series (U) courses are required to complete another one LHP series (U) courses.
- c. Students are responsible for verifying that they register for courses under the correct credit type. Registering courses under the wrong credit type may result in students being unable to fulfil graduation requirements.
- d. The passing grade for all English language proficiency courses remains Grade C for students across all cohorts.

2. Students from the cohort of Academic Session 2025/2026 and prior to that who have not enrolled in any English language proficiency courses.

- a. These students are required to register for English language proficiency courses based on the chart below to successfully fulfil the requirement of **4 University (U) type credits**:

English Course Placement Pathways by Entry Qualification

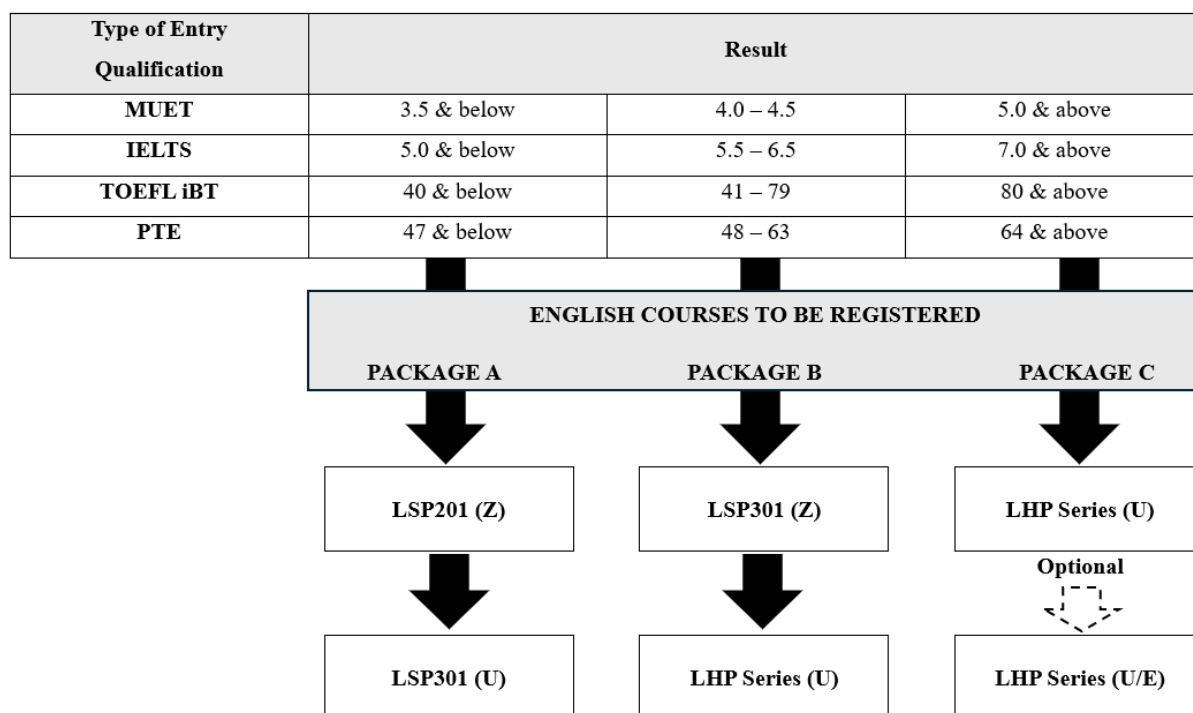


- b. Students with qualifications not listed in the chart will be placed under Package A, subject to equivalency verification by the school where applicable.
- c. Students are responsible for verifying that they register for courses under the correct credit type. Registering courses under the wrong credit type may result in students being unable to fulfil graduation requirements.
- d. The passing grade for all English language proficiency courses remains Grade C for students across all cohorts.

3. Students from the Academic Session 2026/2027 cohort onwards.

- a. These students are required to register for English language proficiency courses based on the chart below to successfully fulfil the requirement of **2 University (U) type credits**:
